QUALIFICATIONS — NVQ

How to obtain your National Vocational Qualification (NVQ)

FITA is able to offer support to floorlayers in obtaining Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Floorcovering Occupations (Construction) through On-Site Assessment (OSAT).

ON-SITE ASSESSMENTS (OSAT)

- SUITABLE FOR BOTH DOMESTIC / COMMERCIAL INSTALLERS.
- On-site assessments are carried out within normal working environments and prequalification paperwork is generally created at a location convenient to the learner.
- · Suitable for experienced workers who need to gain an NVQ without further training.
- Can be completed within a minimum of 16 weeks.
- Funding may be available through CITB or other sources to support this qualification route. Ask for details as funding is limited and conditions will apply.

Membership of the CFA or NICF is not required to register for the programme and is not a requirement for funding eligibility.

All skilled workers are increasingly being required to obtain appropriate CSCS cards to be able to work for clients and most main contractors. Many require them to gain site access.

In turn, to obtain a "Skilled Worker" or Blue CSCS card, you MUST have an NVQ Level 2. Other CSCS cards, for example the Green (or "Labourer's") card, are no longer accepted or renewed for those who are actively involved in the installation of floorcoverings.

Pre-qualification is required to assess eligibility for the NVQ assessment and funding. Conditions apply and limited funding is available.
